Includes: a certified Biologist or Naturalist, lunch and snacks, hydrophone to hear the whale's songs, and material for whale monitoring.

The South Pacific of Costa Rica witnesses an incredible event: every year, 2 different populations of Humpback whales arrive to the tropical warm waters to give birth, raise their babies, and mate. From January to March, we receive the North Population, coming from Alaska, while from July to October we host the curious and friendly South Population. But that's not all! We can also spot Pilot whales, Bryde's whales, and more!

This is unlike your typical whale watching tour! During our whale monitoring, we will use various innovative technologies to study and identify individuals. We will fly a drone, use a hydrophone to record and hear the whale's songs, work on photo identification, and record any strange or interesting behavior. Whales are facing many threats around the world and studying their populations is essential to improve their protection.
